

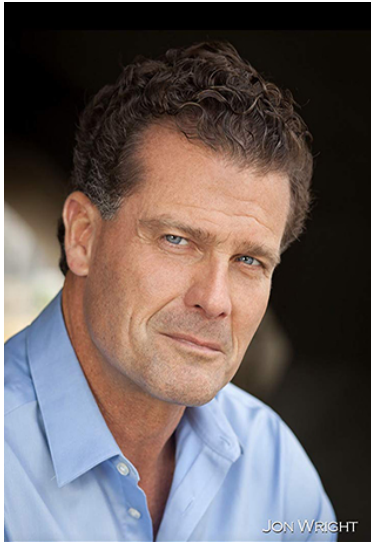

BEST PERFORMANCE BY AN ACTOR

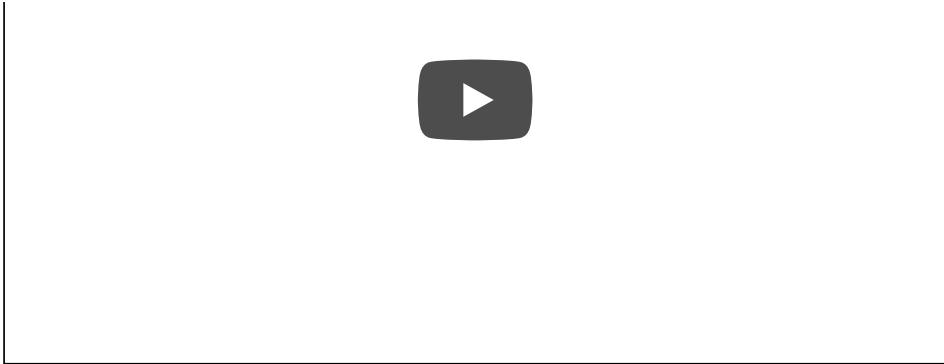


Jon Edwin Wright

Paeca®: 3 Nominations, 1 Win

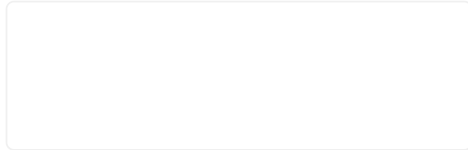

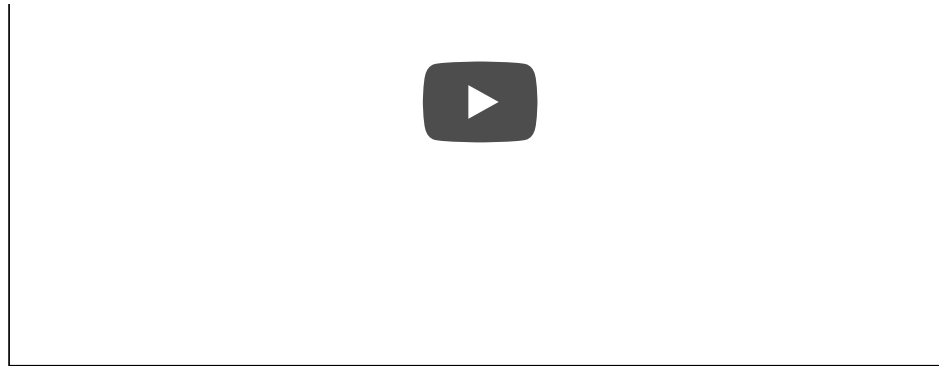
Glossary of Broken Dreams
